Parking in Montréal

You have two options while staying in Montréal: off-street parking and on-street parking.

On-street parking

On-street parking around the Centre Sheraton costs **\$3 per hour** and will be charged based on the following schedule:

 Monday to Friday:
 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. (09h00 to 21h00)

 Saturday:
 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (09h00 to 18h00)

 Sunday:
 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. (13h00 to 18h00)

Off-street parking

The Centre Sheraton offers off-street parking for \$24 per 24 hours and valet parking for \$31 per 24 hours. Valet parking is a better option if you plan on using your vehicle repeatedly, otherwise you will be charged \$24 whenever you leave the parking lot.

The City of Montréal has two parking lots within a 10-minute walk from the Centre Sheraton. They are open from 6 a.m. to midnight. They are reserved for permit holders until Friday at 5 p.m. Parking costs \$3 per hour between 5 p.m. and midnight on Friday, with a maximum of \$15. It costs \$3 per hour between 6 a.m. and midnight on the weekend, with a maximum of \$15.

The two parking lots are located on Sainte-Antoine Street. The following Google Map will show you the location of off-street parking offered by the City of Montréal: maps.google.com

Alternatively, here are some privately-owned off-street parking lots near the Centre Sheraton:

Dominion Square – 1199 Peel Street – a 5-minute walk from the Centre Sheraton. Cost is **\$23 per 24 hours** on weekdays and **\$8** on the weekend. Open 24/7. https://www.vincipark.ca/en/search-for-a-parking-lot/parking-information/?pid=274

Cité du Commerce – 1074 de la Montagne Street – a 5-minute walk from the Centre Sheraton. Cost is **\$19 per 24 hours**. Open from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.

These costs are approximate and do not take into account the fact that the Canadian Championships are held over the Easter weekend. We strongly recommend that you visit a website like Stationnement de Montréal, BestParking, or Parkopedia for more details.
